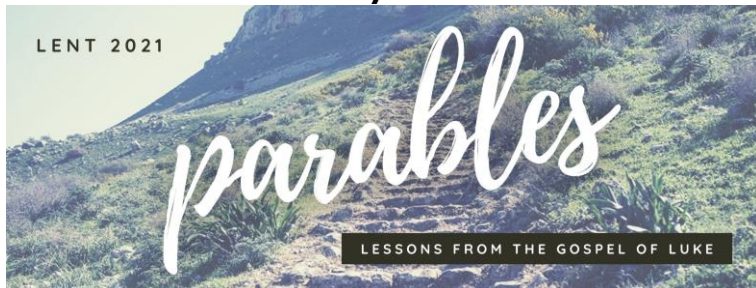


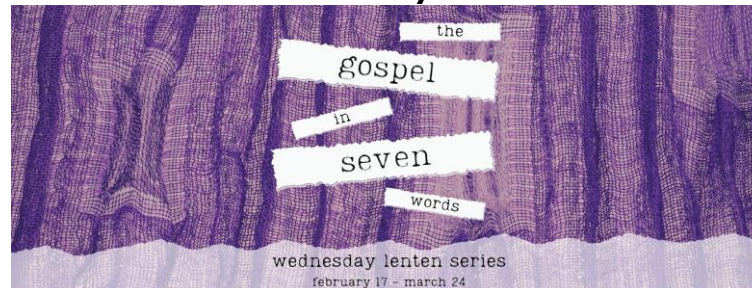
Lenten Reading Plan | February 2021

Sunday Series:



Lent is a season of penitence and prayer, preparing for the celebration of Easter. This Lent we'll focus on our need for forgiveness by learning from the one who came to forgive our sin. This series will focus on the Parables of Jesus in the Gospel of Luke. We'll fix our eyes on Jesus as we make our way to the cross. Each week we will explore a parable, what it reveals about the Kingdom of God and what it teaches us about following the Way of Jesus.

To be a Christian is to be a confessor. When we confess our belief in Christ, we glorify God and extend the grace of God, through Christ Jesus, to more people. The season of Lent is a time to reflect, repent and confess your sin. But it is also a time to confess your faith. Are you prepared to give a confession? If you were asked to explain your faith in Christ, could you? Over the next several weeks, we are going to learn how to confess the faith...in seven words.
